Dear Mr Iliopoulos,

Thank you for your letter to me dated the 16th July, 2013. I was pleased to read that you recently presented the Freedom Housing concept at the Inaugural National Convention of Disability Care Australia in Melbourne.

I know that you have committed considerable effort and resources to develop a concept for a family-governed community to be established to allow people with a disability to live with their families or carers.

I understand that the key element of the Freedom Village housing proposal revolves around the concept of four homes which are connected via a central 'Freedom Key' which contains an adaptable common area space to support the needs of all residents. It would also provide the carers and nurses with the ability to move between the four houses to attend to the care needs of the residents.

I note that you wish to demonstrate the support you have for this concept and to initiate a trial which will involve four volunteer households over an 18 months period which would allow you to optimise the architecture, fit-out and operational methodology.

I wish you success with Freedom Housing's endeavours to develop and establish a new form of disability support accommodation in Victoria and would appreciate being kept informed of any new developments.
